

St. Mary's Episcopal Church Collection (SC206)

Introduction

St. Mary's Episcopal Church was organized in 1857 under the name St. Luke's. The name was changed in 1879 to St. Mary's Episcopal Church, and it absorbed St. George's congregation in 1989. Since its beginning, the Church has had a significant role within the Kansas City community and Western Episcopal Diocese. This collection consists of records created and maintained by church leaders and parishioners.

Historical Sketch

St. Luke's Episcopal Church was organized in 1857 in Kansas City with services given by Reverend Joseph Corbyn. Services were originally held in church buildings around town, until a building for St. Luke's parish was erected at 8th and Walnut Streets in 1867. When Mary Troost died in 1872 her will deeded land for an Episcopal Church to be named St. Mary's Church. To acquire the property, St. Luke's was changed to St. Mary's Episcopal Church. Reverend Henry D. Jardine began his rectorship around this same time and led efforts to build a parish school and All

Saints Hospital (part of St. Luke's Health System), and organize St. Luke's Church burial grounds at Forest Hill Cemetery. A new church building was completed in 1887 and St. Mary's moved to 13th and Holmes, where it remains active today. St. Mary's is the oldest Episcopal Church in Kansas City and the current building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

St. George's Episcopal Church started in Kansas City in 1891 at 32nd and Troost. In 1986 the church was located at 5800 Highland. They closed their doors there and occupied several temporary locations until partnering with St. Mary's church, which allowed the St. George's congregation to hold services in their building. St. George's was officially dissolved by Bishop Arthur Vogel in February 1989, and its congregation's membership transferred to St. Mary's.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains records of St. Mary's administration and operations, meeting minutes of church vestry, reports, financial records, membership and sacramental records, property and building records, correspondence, church newsletters and service programs, news articles about the church, photographs, and audiovisual material. The collection documents the activities and work of the church and its members. Some images have been digitized, and barcode numbers are listed with the folder. Some early records of St. Mary's are housed by the Church.

The St. George's records were found separate from the St. Mary's records. They have been arranged in a series at the beginning of the collection.

This series consists of seven subseries arranged by type of record. Materials in this series were created and compiled by St. George's Episcopal Church. The St. George's congregation met in the St. Mary's Church building beginning in 1986 and later the two congregations merged under St. Mary's.

This subseries consists of records created by the church officials to operate St. George's Church and administer services and programs. Items are arranged by subject and include articles of incorporation, history of St. George's, property records, records of services and programs, and correspondence.

This subseries consists of vestry minutes and includes financial reports and official correspondence. These items are arranged chronologically by date.

This subseries consists of materials related to St. George's social programs within the Blue Hills neighborhood. Items in this subseries were left in their original order.

This subseries consists of articles from newspapers, magazines, and miscellaneous newsletters related to St. George's Church building and parish. These items are arranged by type of publication and thereunder chronologically.

[1-6: Registers of Communicants, Baptisms, Burials, Confirmations, and Marriages, 1891-1989](#)

This subseries consists of parish registers for St. George's that include information on communicants, baptism, burials, confirmations, and marriages. These items are arranged by type of record and thereunder chronologically by date.

This subseries consists of photographs and drawings of St. George's Church building, parishioners, and events. Items are arranged by subject.

This series consists of six subseries arranged by type of record. The records in this series were created to support the operation and administration of St. Mary's Church membership, services, and programs.

This subseries consists of documents providing information on the history of St. Mary's Church and the Episcopal Diocese of West Missouri. Items are arranged by subject.

[2-2: Sermons and Services, 1866-1996](#)

This subseries consists of records of church services, guests, sermons, and other writings related to the content of the services. Items are arranged by type of material.

[2-3: Newsletters and Programs, 1877-2005 and n.d.](#)

This subseries consists of the weekly programs and newsletters of the Church, and is arranged by item type and thereunder chronologically by date.

2-4: Church Associations and Events, 1887-2004 and n.d.

This subseries consists of records relating to various church associations, clubs, and events outside of the general services. Items are arranged by subject.

2-5: Membership, Sacramental, and Related Records, 1857-2004 and n.d.

This subseries consists of records and related information on memberships, baptisms, burials, confirmations, and marriages. These items are arranged by type of record and thereunder chronologically by date.

2-6: St. Luke's Burial Ground, 1871-2005 and n.d.

This subseries consists of records of St. Luke's Burial Grounds. In 1871, Mary Troost deeded land to St. Luke's Episcopal Church (now St. Mary's) to be used as a burial ground. The original location was sold in 1888 for land located in Forest Hill Cemetery at Troost Avenue. Items are arranged by type of record.

Series 3: St. Mary's Legal and Property Records, 1828--2009

This series consists of Land Agreements, Estate Records, and Building Contracts related to St. Mary's Church building and property. Items are arranged by subject.

Series 4: St. Mary's Financial Records, 1888-1999

This series consists of reports, bank statements, and donation information that document the church's finances. Some Treasurer's reports also contain pages of vestry minutes. This series is arranged by type of record.

Series 5: St. Mary's Vestry Minutes, 1857-2002

This series consists of vestry minutes and includes some financial reports. Items in this series are arranged chronologically by date.

Series 6: St. Mary's Correspondence, 1886-2005 and n.d.

This series consists of correspondence of church officials, congregation members, and others in the Episcopal Diocese. Items in this series are arranged chronologically by date.

Series 7: St. Mary's Clergy Files, 1837-2014 and n.d.

These files consist of information compiled by and about clergy members. Items in the files were left in their original arrangement and the files are arranged by subject.

Series 8: News Articles, 1878-2007

This series consists of articles from newspapers, magazines, and miscellaneous newsletters related to St. Mary's Church building and congregation. Items are arranged by subject and thereunder chronologically by date.

Series 9: Photographs and Audiovisual, 1874-2011 and n.d.

This series consists of photographs, drawings, and video footage found in the collection. Items in this series are arranged by subject.

Series 10: Miscellaneous Oversize, 1884-2007

This series consists of various oversize items and can be found in an oversize box and map cabinet. Items include blueprints, flag, property related documents, and poster displays for St. Mary's Sesquicentennial,
